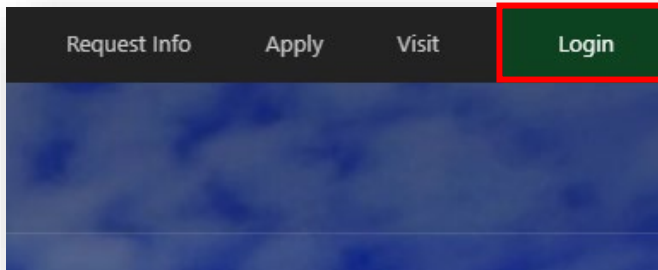
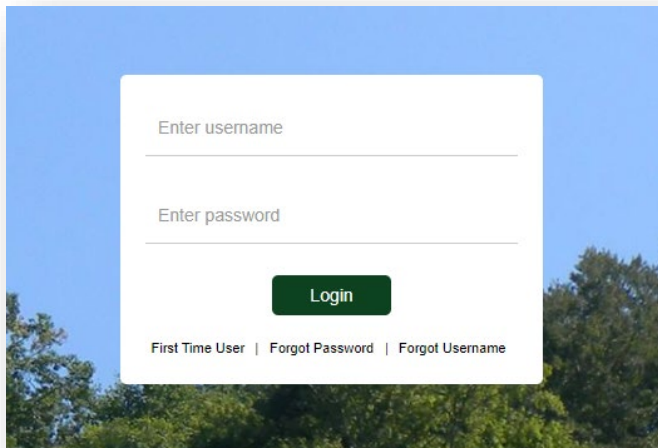


#### Accessing My Clear Creek Apps:

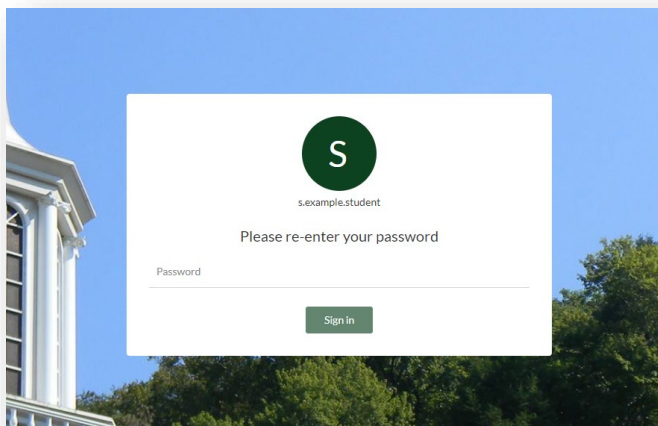
1. Go to the Clear Creek website: <https://www.ccbbc.edu/>
2. Click on the green Login button at the top-right corner of the page.



3. Type in your Clear Creek email address and password. Then select "Login".



4. The first time you login, you will be prompted to re-enter your password. Type it in and select "Sign in".



5. Select your security questions from the four drop-down menus and type in your answers in the boxes.

**Tips for choosing a good security question:**

1. Don't pick a question that someone could easily guess or find out the answer to by looking at your resume or social networking profile
2. Pick a question with an answer that is easy for you to remember
3. Don't write your security question down where someone could find it

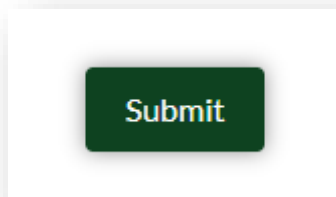

7. You will need to add at least one other recovery option (Email Recovery or Phone Recovery). Select one of the tabs and follow the directions on the page.

### Account Recovery Settings

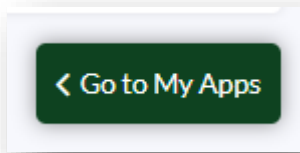
To facilitate password recovery, Security Questions must be added to your account.

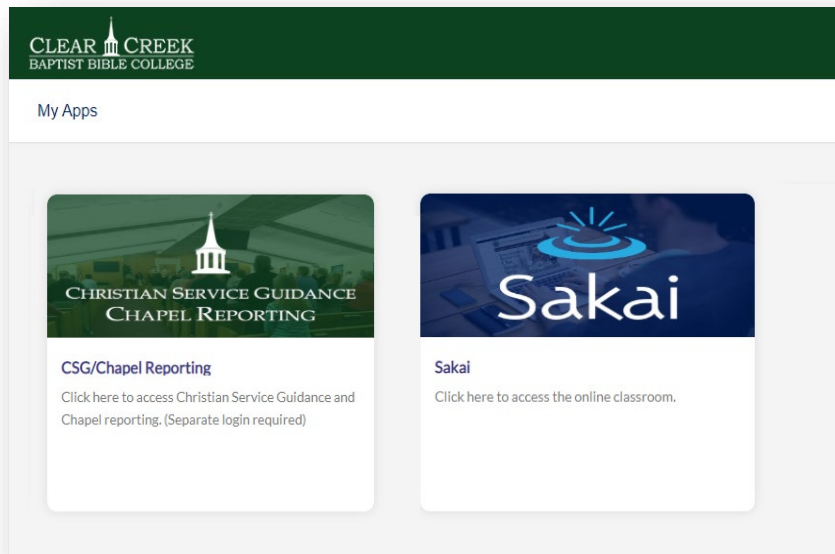

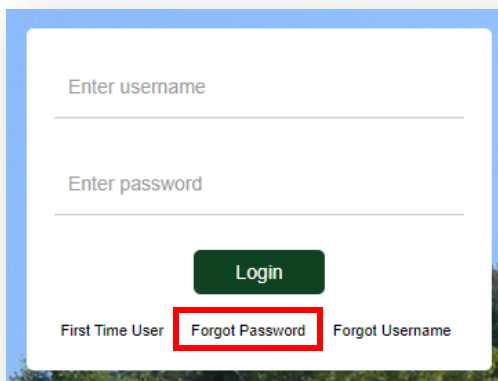
8. After you have set up your additional recovery options, you can view your apps. Click on the button “Go to My Apps”.



9. Select the app you wish to access. Since you set up your security questions and recovery options, you will access this page when you login in the future.



10. If you cannot remember your password, click on the “Forgot Password” link and follow the instructions on the page.
