

Apartments. A security deposit of \$100.00 for full-time students/\$50.00 for commuter students, must be paid before keys are issued. A \$25.00 Kelly Hall deposit is required by the end of spring semester for any returning student to reserve a room in these housing areas for the following school year. This deposit will be applied to college expenses upon enrollment in the fall. The Kelly Hall Supervisor must be notified in writing by July 1 if you do not plan to return or your deposit will be forfeited. Failure to pay this deposit by the end of spring semester will result in a \$25.00 non-refundable KH housing re-application fee before housing will be assigned for fall semester Kelly Hall and Courts Apartments rates are calculated on a semester basis. At the end of the spring semester, summer rates are calculated on a weekly basis and charged each month. (See the Kelly Hall or Student Handbook for more information.)

The Kelly Hall Supervisor reserves the right to consolidate empty living spaces or make reassignments when vacancies occur.

## 5. MEALS

Kelly Hall offers a choice of three meal plans:(see below) lunch/supper; lunch only; or single meal cash purchase. You may indicate your preference during registration, and your account is charged accordingly, except for the cash plan.

## 6. REFUNDS

Campus housing (excluding dormitory space) is committed for the entire month. Consequently, a student who withdraws from housing before the end of the month may be charged for the full month. Refunds on room and board at the dormitory will be granted on the basis of the actual number of weeks remaining in the semester with a part week being considered a full week.

**TUITION REFUNDS:**

Refunds will be made in accordance with U. S. Regulation 34 CFR 668.22, and the Federal Student Financial Aid Handbook as follows:

- a) 100% - withdrawal on 1st day of class (less permitted fee of \$100 or 5% of charges - whichever is less).
- b) 90% - withdrawal after 1<sup>st</sup> day of class through 1<sup>st</sup> 10% of enrollment period.
- c) 50% - withdrawal after 1<sup>st</sup> 10% through 1<sup>st</sup> 25% of enrollment period.
- d) 25% - withdrawal after 1<sup>st</sup> 25% through 1<sup>st</sup> 60% of enrollment period.
- e) Day after 60% of enrollment period - NO REFUND.

Withdrawal is not complete until student housing has been vacated and the student has received a copy of the completed withdrawal form. A forwarding address form must be completed and returned to the business office along with all mailbox keys.

**STUDENT HOUSING**

**1. SECURITY DEPOSIT/MARRIED STUDENTS**

A security deposit of one month's rent must be paid by each resident planning to live in campus-owned housing and must be paid before keys are issued. Before a student moves in, a check-in inspection is conducted by a representative of the physical plant department accompanied by each new tenant. A housing inspection checklist is reviewed and signed by both.

Security deposits are refunded after student moves if following guidelines are met:

- A. Student graduates and premises are left in same condition as they were found.
- B. Student moving before graduation gives a written notice of moving date and premises are left in same condition as they were found.
- C. All keys, including mailbox keys, have been turned in and a forwarding address form must be on file in the Business Office.
- D. The student has a zero or credit balance on his or her account. If not, the security deposit is applied to the outstanding balance.

**2. RENT**

Rent is charged each semester on the following basis: fall semester (August-December); spring semester (January-May); and summer terms (June and July); rates for Kelly Hall are charged by the semester per number of weeks.

**3. VACATING STUDENT HOUSING**

It is necessary for students who graduate to vacate student housing by May 31, to allow time to get houses ready for new students. You must submit a written request to the Physical Plant office to stay beyond the May 31, deadline. Each request will be granted or denied (depending on incoming student need) and answered in writing by the Physical Plant office. Students completing course requirements in December must vacate student housing by December 31. Graduates need to give the date they intend to move out.

Any student who moves before he graduates is required to give a written notice. Failure to give a written notice may mean forfeiting the security deposit (one month's rent).

**4. KELLY HALL/SINGLE AND COMMUTER STUDENTS**
