**Context**

“Student Right-to-Know” data is calculated by the Integrated Postsecondary Education Database System (IPEDS) from annual institutional submissions.

AA and BA Graduation Rates (150%) for academic year 2021-22 may reflect COVID-related impacts on institutional enrollment.

\*The Master of Arts in Ministry was launched in September 2020 as a self-paced competency-based program with rolling monthly admissions. The program was adjusted to a traditional semester-based calendar in Fall 2023. The college established an aspirational goal for Graduation Rate (150%) of 45% for this program. Graduation Rate (150%) data for the Fall 2023 entering cohort is not yet available.

CCBBC considers both employment in ministry or graduate school/seminary attendance as “placement” for purposes of placement rate calculation.

Association for Biblical Higher Education (ABHE) Bible Knowledge Exam (BKE) exit scores are harvested from BA candidates for graduation during their final semester of enrollment. Exam scores are also analyzed for both entrance and exit comparison as well as comparison to national norms established by the instrument.
