Fee Payment and Refunds

All Dual Enrollment students are required to either pay their semester in full or enter into a payment plan for the entirety of their remaining balance prior to the start of the semester. Any student whose account has not been paid in full or setup a payment plan by the add/drop deadline each semester will not be permitted to enter/access classes and have their registration voided. In such cases, any portion of the tuition paid will be refundable in full.

A student may drop all courses for which they are registered at any time before the first day of class and receive a full tuition refund. This registration change will be subject to the schedule change fee.

After the add/drop date, all matriculated students will be responsible for all charges on their student account.

Admission and Academic Policies

Admission Policies

Students eligible for CCBBC's Dual Enrollment Program must meet these qualifiers:

1. Be a junior or senior in high school.
2. Apply through the admissions application.
3. Pay the \$50 admission application fee.
4. Obtain the signature of a high school counselor and parent or authorized homeschool instructor affirming the applicant's academic ability to complete college level coursework and the sufficiency of the CCBBC courses for high school credit.

Academic Policies

Students enrolled in CCBBC's Dual Enrollment program have the advantage of receiving college credit while taking high school courses. This allows them to minimize the duplication of courses taken in high school and college and can potentially shorten the time required to complete an undergraduate degree. In addition, CCBBC's affordable dual enrollment rate will significantly reduce a student's higher education cost while receiving an accredited, biblical education.

Courses offered through the Dual Enrollment Program will present a rigorous curriculum and will introduce qualified students to college-level work for which they may earn both high school and college credit. Curriculum alignment between Clear Creek Baptist Bible College faculty and high school will ensure that the content is of a higher academic standard. All courses offered by the college are available to Dual Enrollment Students; not all courses will meet the needs of high school credit. Each student will need to verify credit eligibility with their individual school.

There are two ways to earn dual enrollment credit through Clear Creek Baptist Bible College:

1. Main Campus Courses: Students can earn dual enrollment credit by attending classes on our main campus in Pineville, KY. This option offers the true college campus experience.
2. Online Courses: This option entails all of the time and location conveniences that online education has to offer.

A student can earn up to 28 hours through Clear Creek Baptist Bible College Dual Enrollment.
