## DIRECTOR OF FINANCIAL AID AND ADMISSIONS COUNSELOR JOB DESCRIPTION

## PRINCIPAL FUNCTION

The Director of Financial Aid and Admissions Counselor is responsible to the Dean of Administrative Affairs for the office of financial aid at Clear Creek Baptist Bible College.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Coordinate all activities relating to the financial aid process; beginning with initial contacts from a prospective student inquiring about possible financial aid to funds actually being received and applied to a student's account.
- 2. Prepare and process institutional financial aid for all students enrolled.
- 3. Help locate and distribute any and all financial assistant available to students.
- 4. Represent the college to any entity involved with funding any portion of a student's expenses while enrolled at CCBBC including but not limited to: federal government, state agencies, Veteran's Administration, state conventions, churches and individuals.
- 5. Be available for financial counseling with students as needed.
- 6. Coordinate with the Dean of Students the Adoptive Family Program.
- 7. Maintain detailed, accurate financial aid information for use in annual audit.
- 8. All Title IV applications and programs must be kept current and approved by the Department of Education.
- 9. Create a strategic plan for the use of endowed financial aid funds for retention and recruitment with the Dean of Administrative Affairs.
- 10. Assist Admissions in the contacting of prospective student and in travel occasionally.

## QUALIFICATIONS FOR POSITION

The Director of Financial Aid should have:

- 1. A bachelor's degree as minimum educational requirement with a degree in business or administration or related field and/or related work experience which qualifies for position of director of financial aid.
- 2. Ability to meet deadlines and maintain detailed, accurate records.
- 3. Willingness, patience and strong desire to help students in all phases of the financial aid process at Clear Creek Baptist Bible College.
- 4. Willingness to travel a few times per year to learn all phases of financial aid and to assist Admissions in recruit.
