

NEW DEGREE: BIBLICAL STUDIES

The key role of a pastor is to apply the truth of scripture to his congregation.

Clear Creek Baptist Bible College has been committed to training pastors for nearly 100 years. Like the Apostle Paul, Clear Creek challenges men called to the pastoral ministry to "study to show yourself approved before God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15)

Beginning in Fall 2024, the college is offering a new degree option that builds on our 97-year tradition of Bible training.

The Bachelor of Arts in Biblical Studies degree, consisting of 120 hours, is designed to equip students to accurately interpret and apply biblical truth within contemporary life and in their specific ministry context.

In addition to taking thirty-two hours of Bible, students pursuing this degree will be required to take courses like How We Got the Bible, Applied Hermeneutics, Apologetics, and the Bible, as well as Hebrew 1-2 and Greek 1-2. This degree will provide the foundation for a calling to an exegetical Bible ministry or for the individual who plans to earn a postgraduate degree at a seminary.

In addition to the seventy-six hours core of studies (Bible/Theology and General Studies), the new degree consists of eleven hours of required Ministry Studies, eight hours of electives in Ministry Studies, and twenty-five hours of Bible Teaching Studies.

What sets this degree apart from our other ministry degrees is the emphasis in biblical languages, enhanced hermeneutics, and apologetics. It gives the pastor additional guidance in using the tools that enhance the exegetical study of the Scripture, preparing him for that preaching and/or teaching moment with the entire congregation or small group. At the same time, the degree also covers those other areas of pastoral ministry in which pastors regularly engage.

As a co-developer of this new degree, an Old Testament professor for thirty-five years, and forty years as a pastor, I find this degree an exciting addition to Clear Creek's ministry degrees. Looking into the Bachelor of Arts Biblical Studies is well worth a student's time, knowing that the faculty and staff of Clear Creek are praying for them as they seek God's will for their life in His ministry.

NEW DEGREE:CHRISTIAN APOLOGETICS

Defending the faith is a central focus of the Christian faith.

By its very calling, the Christian faith spreads outward toward others, which will inevitably lead to questions. Christians need to be ready to defend the truth when these questions are presented.

This means believers are to present and defend the truth God has revealed. God has revealed Himself in a general and special way (Psalm 19); therefore, believers should be ready to speak on issues such as creation, God's existence, the nature of humanity, morality, sin, truth, ethics, evil, God's standard, the Bible, the deity of Christ, miracles, the resurrection, and salvation in Christ alone. It is the responsibility of all believers to guard the truth God has revealed. It cannot be given to anyone else.

Clear Creek Baptist Bible College wants to help prepare men and women to defend the truth, and we have developed a new degree program to provide such instruction—the Bachelor of Arts in Christian Apologetics. The new degree program will also help prepare pastors to deal with issues from the pulpit. These men will sometimes have to engage in apologetics with the people sitting in the pews.

This degree will benefit even those who desire to better engage the culture with the gospel. Those who enroll in the degree will take forty-four hours in Bible and theology, seventeen hours in ministry studies, thirty-two hours of general studies, six elective hours, and twenty-one hours in apologetics.

Each course seeks to present a defense from a biblical worldview and framework. Apologetics begins with an understanding of the call that all believers have from the Lord to defend the faith. No defense is complete unless it is guided by Scripture and the conviction and drawing of the Holy Spirit.
